The various activities for which we have applied to the Court for support will, together, help some 10,000 Shoah survivors in the first calendar year.

It is impossible to estimate the number of people within the wider public who will be impacted.

The total program costs in the first calendar year are \$250,000.

The average per person cost in the first calendar year, taking into consideration only the Shoah survivors who will be impacted by our programs and activities is \$25.
