
APPLICATION OF BURT NEUBORNE

**MEMORANDUM
OF THE STATE OF ISRAEL REGARDING
APPLICATION OF BURT NEUBORNE FOR FEE AWARD**

Since 2004, the State of Israel has participated in this case as *parens patriae* for class members living in Israel. In the course of that participation, counsel for the State of Israel have worked with class counsel, Burt Neuborne, and have studied the record of the case in the proceedings that took place from the time of the settlement to the present day. Based on that involvement and review, we conclude that there is no reason why Professor Neuborne should not be compensated at an appropriate rate for his time devoted to the administration of the case. We express no opinion on the amount or rate of compensation sought. These are matters within the Court's discretion.
